The following information will be helpful to have to hand when you report.

By working together and with as much relevant information as possible it will help us to address the problem. Below is the information that would be helpful to have before reporting – please complete as much as possible and have it ready when you contact the relevant organisation.

Specific location – this is key to assist officers in addressing the issue.
Times and dates it is happening. Officers cannot target the problem without this.
Any descriptions of persons involved or names if known. We also need to know if
children are involved or present.
Any vehicles involved. If possible, the registration number of vehicle as it is possible for
officers to target vehicles away from the area which then safeguards our community.
Consistent responsible reporting helps in highlighting areas and offending patterns.
Have you or anyone else you know reported this before?
Please think about whether you are happy to be contacted either in person or on the
telephone. Anonymous calls whilst still useful can limit what action officers take
